### **DEAR SUPPORTERS...**

Jesus taught His followers to go the second mile. He told them if someone hit them on the one cheek they should offer the other cheek also. We can clearly see that Jesus wasn't ignoring or bypassing the law that had been given years ago, He superseded it. A Roman mile was 1,000 paces, which would be about 9/10 of a mile. A Roman soldier, if he wished to, could demand anyone to carry his pack for one mile. Their packs often weighed around 66 pounds. I can just imagine how the Jews would have hated to be subjected to this unpleasant task. When Jesus said that we should go the second mile, He meant that we should do more than what is expected or required of us. Going the second mile affects every part of our life. It needs to become a way of life.

There are no traffic jams on this second mile. It may be difficult to live this kind of life but it would have a miraculous effect on our homes and communities. It is selfishness which is the cause of our misery. The healing power of Christ, found in the doctrine of going the second mile, would do wonders to still arguments and accusation, fault finding and evil speaking. This does not mean that we never rebuke or discipline a divisive, quarrel-

some person.


I read the Genesis 24 story again of how Abraham's servant found a wife for Isaac. As the servant approached the well, He prayed to God that the girl who would offer to give him a drink and also

water for his camels would be the one that should be chosen. Even before he was done praying, Rebekah came to the well, bearing her pitcher on her shoulder. He asked her for a drink, and she guickly took her pitcher off of her shoulder, gave him a drink and offered to give water to all of his camels. Judging her by her response, I think she lived a second mile kind of life. She did more than what was expected or required for her to do. A thirsty camel can drink up to 53 gallons at one time! Abraham's servant had ten camels with him, which could mean that she may have had to carry 500 gallons! Even if we would estimate on the low side and say that the camels would have only needed 10 gallons each, that would still mean that she would need to carry 100 gallons. At a minimum, twenty-five trips going down the steps to draw the water and twenty-five trips coming back up. Up and down, up and down she went, all because she volunteered to go the second mile. Little did she realize how God would use and bless her in the years to come... all because of going the second mile.

Thank you for your support in the work of reaching into prisons. Many people are still seeking and asking for help. We want to use the opportunities that God has given to us, and be faithful in pointing others to the Savior.
