The word quick is an Old English word that means living, alive, animate, characterized by the presence of life. The Word of God is alive and full of life! It produces life. It is Life. This fact is obvious when we reflect on how God created the world. When He spoke, things came into existence and became alive. His words are full of power. When Jesus was with His disciples, He spoke and the storm ceased. Dead Lazarus had to come forth out of the grave.

...Please I am asking you for another Strong's Concordance? I use it all the time to find verses, and especially when I am writing letters or documents.

Dear Brothers,

I am so excited and elated to be able to write you again. One reason I haven't been able to write letters is because they have me on so many pills. Besides, I have been in and out of the hospital all of 2024 and some of 2025. But thanks be to God I am able today! Glory... Glory... Glory!

As you know, brother, I have congestive heart failure. I just had another heart attack and I have been so weak. After having this last heart attack I went back to the hospital for a follow-up and was diagnosed with liver cancer. They moved me to Lois M. DeBerry Special Needs Facility in Nashville, TN. So far, brother, I have had two Chemotherapy treatments and I have another one coming up next week. Doing these treatments makes me feel so very weak. Sometimes it is so hard to get out of bed. But today I am feeling so much better so I decided to write you a few lines on paper. :)

The Bible says if any among you are sick let him call on the elders of the Church so he may be healed, so I am asking each of you to pray for me, and please keep my wife, Mrs. Brenda, in your many prayers. I truly believe the Lord Jesus Christ brought me through 5 heart attacks. Surely He can heal me of liver cancer. Glory! Hallelujah! Glory!

Brothers, thank you all so very much for your love and encouraging words each month. Your letters and the testimonies of other men behind bars have been a blessing to all of us. Please say hello to all the Brothers & Sisters for us. Thank you. Thank you... Thank you!!!

Until pen touches paper again: We'll meet y'all here, there, or in the air. Glory... Glory!

Dearest Siblings in Christ,

I pray that peace and joy are furnishings in your households, and that love and grace have a fragrance that is sweet and follows you all **EVERYWHERE**.

I am unable to adequately articulate my appreciation of the letter dated 6/11/25, **much** more now that I have looked at the Scriptures & the class. The writer spoke of false doctrines that run rampant, and little foxes spoiling the vines.

I have recently returned to some correspondence Bible studies that I had to put on hold to engage in the ministry here where my study time was directed. [Studying the Bible is] different and more intentional – reading where I am in this prison with, as you know well, particularly a special section of the lost. As God has allowed for the change in my devotional time, I find myself in a study in the book of Romans.

And I'm wondering **what Bible** is this person reading, and how is he coming to the conclusions he's coming to regarding **God's character**? How does he get something so right, then contaminate it with something else that in my opinion is **soooo.... OFF?**

My Christ-Centered Recovery group continues. Last Wednesday (18th) we had a "Jesus" bingo fellowship. I had some prizes that other inmates had donated, and the men had fun and God was glorified. I used Scripture addresses to identify the authenticity of the card. So when someone yells "JESUS" the Scripture verifies the name as true.

Due to some personnel changes (namely the Warden), I have not received the dictionaries yet, as some of our volunteers are suspended, and we hope that will change in the next two months.

I'm working on a coordinated effort of 2 living areas doing a Gospel of John Bible Study. There are some dynamics to iron out, and I'm hoping to get some incentives to draw more in.

Well, I'd better close here before I have to start creating chapters and verses. I don't ever have to see your faces to know that you all are beautiful people.
