Dear CFPM,

I want to give thanks to our Lord and Savior, Jesus, for making a way for me to even be able to write to you. I've been wanting to reach out to you for sometime now, yet I've been unable to because I lacked the resources (paper, stamps and envelope).

God provides in due season... As it turned out, one of the new brothers blessed me with the supplies. I explained to him that I had been trying to write you. God has a way of working things out that is unlike anything man can wrap his mind around. I'm just grateful that He's able to use me however He pleases.

There are times when I think back on life and tell myself: "If you fail to be grateful for all God has forgiven you, and if you allow Satan to take you back down that dark, pain-filled road, then you can't be upset if God burns you up in hell with Satan. That will happen if you decide to make Satan your god and turn your back on the TRUE GOD AND FATHER."

Sometimes I pinch myself to be sure I'm not dreaming... like is this really me that God reveals all these things to? Is it really me that He's using to call people to salvation as I walk through the valley of the shadow of death in prison?

When I moved to the cell block that I am housed on, I was put in a special housing unit for the worst of the worst here at the Florida State Prison. Jesus was unheard of. The place was plagued by typical rough cell block talk, and no one's mind was on Christ.

Being newly saved, I was determined not to be affected by it. I wanted to be all in for Christ. From the time I woke till the time I slept, I sang and talked about the Word of God. Some didn't like it... several of the officers could be heard making off white statements, yet I held firm. There were some minor trials that I won't waste time explaining, because God delivered me.

God was able to work! He sent a whirlwind and moved a few people. Now not only is there peace back here, but God used me to hold Bible studies on the wing! Everyone participates! All have accepted Christ except one man who talks to seven or eight different people that are not there with him in his one-man cell. He used to yell and get belligerent any time he heard me preach the Word. He doesn't do that anymore! Some of us are praying for him, that God can restore him from the demons that have him bound.

Even through minor differences, the Spirit made a way for forgiveness and growth. Everyone is eager to grow in Christ, so we daily have Bible-based fellowship or an in-depth Bible study.

We have a great fellowship in Christ and everyone's faith is growing. All glory be to God!
