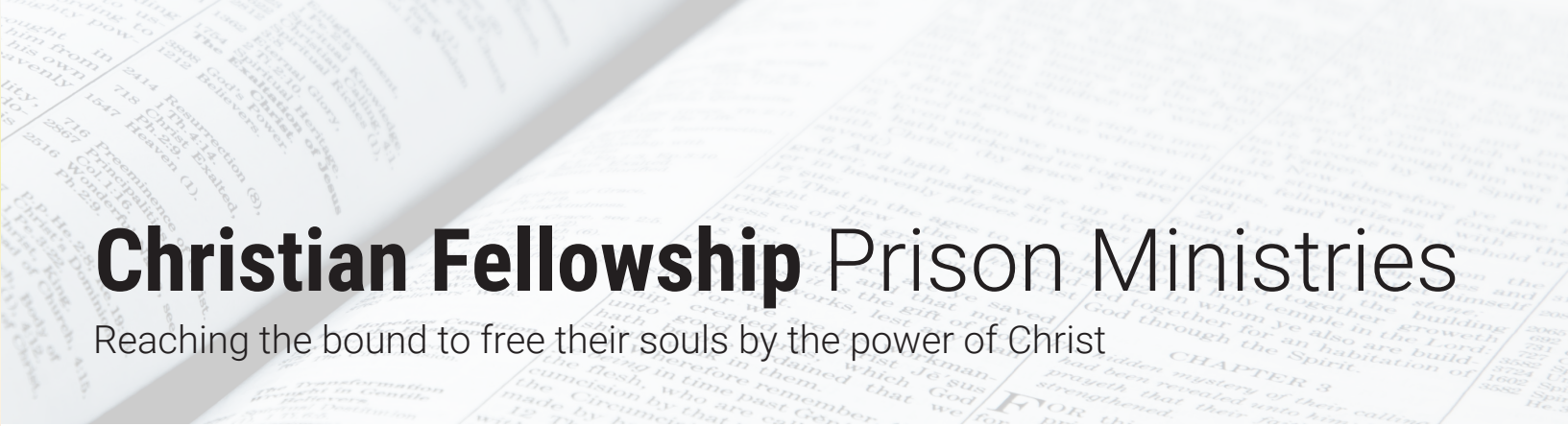

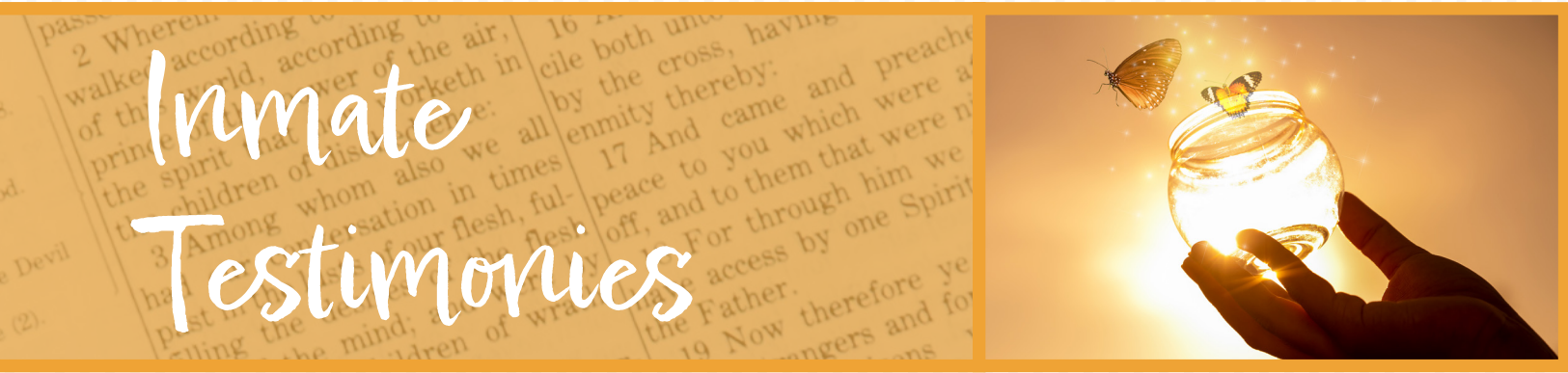

About 22 years ago, I wrote your ministry and received a Strong's Concordance. I still have that Concordance and it is in surprisingly good condition. I use it regularly. Thank you.

The reason that I am writing is that a brother wrote to you all and received a KJV Bible with cross-references. My current Bible is quite worn and nearly coming apart and I was hoping that you all would be able to provide me with one. I have been incarcerated for 27 years and am currently serving a natural life sentence. I received Jesus as my Lord and Saviour on the night of my arrest on May 12, 1999. He has been my Rock and my Shield ever since.

I am currently serving as a Field Minister at this institution. I share the Gospel with inmates in the Control Management (CM) dorms as well as the Mental Health dorms. God is truly building a holy army in the prison system. If you can help me with a KJV Reference Bible it would be greatly appreciated.

Dear brethren at Christian Fellowship Prison Ministries,

Greetings of grace and peace be unto you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ.

I pray this letter finds you doing well. All is well here. I wanted to write to you and give you an update. As of this week, the Lord has promoted me to the head-table, as 1 of 2 men that lead our Messianic Community. It is an awesome responsibility. The Lord is blessing me at every turn and using me to edify and uplift the men here.

I came to know the Lord in the late 80's. By my teens, I was off track and off course. Fast forward many years, I was badly off course. 2018, I'm locked up. 2019, I'm sentenced to a 20/10 split. While in Orlando CFRC, I heard of you and took your Bible Study course. June 12, 2019, I received my first prison Bible, a KJV Bible, from you.

I've grown in leaps and bounds since then, and with so much free-time, I vowed I'd read the Bible through each year I'm down. I've read the KJV, NIV, NKJ, NCT, CSB, TLB, NLT, Life Recovery, and now KJV again. My first Bible (at age 10) was KJV. Now I currently have two Bibles. The KJV you sent me and a MacArthur Study Bible, LSB. Next year I'll be reading the LSB (Legacy Standard Bible), potentially as a free-man! Right now, it is very possible that I will be a free-man in the next 1-3 years. [The Lord] has a plan and a time for all things, and He is in control. My prayer is His will be done.

Thank you again for my Bible and for being part of my transforming and renewing. (Romans 12) Thank you for visiting me in prison with your letters (Matt. 25: 34-40). As the song says, "Thank you for giving to the Lord. I am a life that was changed."
